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SHORT DESCRIPTION OF JOB

The City of Fremont Human Services Department is seeking an exceptional professional to join its management team. The Clinical Supervisor will provide clinical and administrative leadership to the Aging and Family Services Division. The mission of the Aging and Family Services Division is to foster a high quality of life for older adults through its Senior Support Services. The Senior Support Services employs a team of caring professionals from diverse backgrounds which include social workers, a public health nurse, counselors, and peers who will work closely with counselors, peers and other department staff to provide cohesive wrap-around services for older adults and their families.

SHORT DESCRIPTION OF QUALIFICATIONS NEEDED

The successful candidate will have any combination of education and/or experience that has provided the knowledge, skills and abilities necessary for satisfactory job performance. A typical way to obtain the required knowledge and skills would be: A Master's degree in clinical psychology, social work or related field, and five years of counseling or social work experience, two years of which have included the supervision of licensed/professional staff.

Experience working with older adults and older adult programs is required. Possession of a clinical license, such as a as an MFCC, LCSW or Clinical Psychologist is required. A valid Class C California Driver's License is required at time of appointment. (Failure to maintain this license will result in discipline up to and including termination. This classification requires the ability to travel independently within and outside of the City limits to fulfill the assigned duties and responsibilities.)
